Location is Key

Know the location of your interview, how long it will take you to get there, and at what time. Use tools like Google Maps to set a future arrival time and account for traffic. Always buffer your travel time by an extra 15 minutes to ensure you arrive early.

Arrive Early and Composed

Once you arrive, spend some time in your car taking deep breaths and reviewing your notes about the company and the interviewers. Aim to be at least 10 minutes early so you can walk into the interview calm, cool, and collected.

Never bring coffee or snacks to an interview. Most likely, the interviewer will offer you a beverage when you arrive.

Knowledge About the Company

It's crucial to have some understanding of what the company does, including its latest news or press releases. This shows that you're interested in and have done your homework about the company.

Bring a Notebook

Carry a small notebook with prepared notes about who you're meeting and information about the company. This notebook can also be used to jot down notes during the interview.

Note-taking as a Breather

Taking notes gives you a chance to break eye contact and take a moment before answering the next question. It helps you stay composed and thoughtful throughout the interview.
